Welcome all to the 2023 Edom Art Festival!

I am Beth Brown, your festival director. I am the former owner of Potters Brown pottery in Edom since 1971, and this year I will be returning as your Director, and enlisting the Edom Craft Community for a group effort in producing the best show ever, and maybe the only artist produced festival in Texas. We do shows ourselves, so we are in tune to your needs and requests.

This year we are celebrating our 51st year since the show was founded by my late husband Doug Brown. What started many years ago as an invitational and now a juried show, we consider our artists our creative family being that we are artists ourselves, and we treat you as such, which makes us truly unique among art shows. The Edom Art Festival is produced by the Edom Craft Community, a non-profit established in 1978, and we are hosting our 51st festival this year.

FESTIVAL STANDARDS

The type of work acceptable and eligible is Fine Art and Fine Craft. All work exhibited must be original art produced by the artist. One of a kind, multiples, series or limited editions (which must be signed and numbered by the artist) will be considered. The artist must have conceived the design and executed the finished product.

Work exhibited must be consistent with submitted images. EAF reserves the right to request removal of any items which, in its sole judgment, do not conform to show guidelines. If entire inventory does not comply, the artist will be asked to leave with no refund.

ARTISTS BOOTHS

Size: Each artist will have a 10' X 10' space. Double booth space is 10' x 20'. Tents, tables and chairs will be provided by the artist. This is an outdoor show on grass, and dog ties are acceptable. We do experience weather so be advised and prepared.

No electricity will be provided to booths. EAF requires that artists use white top tents for booth display during the festival. There is room to unload and load your vehicle by your booth, but respect of others is mandatory.

The majority of artists set up on Friday. If you do not I will contact you as to where your booth space is for your early arrival on Saturday.

Booth sharing: If two or more artists work together in producing a single product, they must apply as a team and occupy one booth space. Two artists may share a booth, but both must be juried separately according to guidelines.

Security: Overnight security will be provided on Friday and Saturday but EAF cannot assume liability for damage, loss or theft of artist's work.

Sales: All sales will be conducted by individual artist. Artists retain all revenue from sale of their work. Artists are required to collect and pay 7.25% sales tax on all items sold. The Texas State Comptroller does check.

We do provide Texas Cell Net to access the wifi on site, and hopefully there will be no snafus, but be prepared.

APPLICATION PROCEDURE

Please submit 4 digital images of your current, original work, and 1 image showing your booth display with no people in your booth, total of 5 images. These images must be emailed to info@edomarts. com Application is done by filling out the form and submitting with payment, or printing and mailing the form along with jury fee to PO Box 383, Edom, Tx. 75754.

You do have the option this year to charge your fees by submitting the form. Checks will be sent thru the mail to the address above with your application. These must be postmarked by May 10. Call if you have any questions. If we need larger images for press we will contact you.

If you are a new artist especially, you MUST fill out the description of your work to be juried. We have need information about your work and process. Email more info if needed with images so we can better understand your work and process.

A jury fee of \$15 is also due at this time.

Once accepted, a congrats letter will be sent along with a booth form which includes payment for booth and other vital info. A lease will also be sent for you to return. Booth fee is paid by June 15, you have made a commitment to exhibit in the 2023, Edom Art Festival. However, we know that unexpected things come up, so cancellation date is August 1, and no refunds after this date. We will have a waiting list this year.

HOSPITALITY

We are pleased to offer snacks, beverages and ice throughout the event and booth sitters will also be available. An Artists Party will be held for artists on Saturday evening directly after the show for dinner, drinks and an opportunity to say how much we appreciate you! I am excited about meeting our new artists for 2023, and seeing old friends.

Looking forward to a great year.
